## The Amazing Biotech Race: Saskatchewan's National Biotech Week Celebrations

**Saskatoon, SK:** It was so much fun last year that we are doing it again! The Amazing Biotech Race will be held for the second year on Thursday, September 20<sup>th</sup> at Innovation Place.

The goal of this event is to help bioscience students get into the community and connect with businesses, meet people and learn a bit more about what's happening in Saskatoon's bioscience cluster.

SIAST BioScience Technology Program students are mixed with high school students from Evan Hardy, Centennial, and Bedford Road Collegiates and split into teams, encouraging networking and a healthy dose of competition. Costumes are part of the fun.

The Amazing Biotech Race starts at the Atrium at Innovation Place, where teams receive their first clues. Innovation Place companies serve as checkpoints where students take part in lab challenges, answer skill testing questions and gather clues in order to complete the race.

Blaine Chartrand, Program Head for the SIAST BioScience Technology Program, was the inventor of the Amazing Biotech Race. "It's a great way to get students to connect with industry in their chosen field. We hope that including the high school students may encourage them to think about bioscience as a career option."
