Wilf Keller wins Lifetime Achievement Award

On June 7th, Wilf Keller, president and CEO for Ag-West Bio, was honoured with a Lifetime Achievement Award by The Society for In Vitro Biology. This honour “is awarded to those scientists who have achieved academic excellence in their field of study, and to honour those who have made significant contributions to the field of in vitro biology, and/or in the development of novel technologies that have advanced in vitro biology.”

The SIVB Board agreed unanimously that Keller’s contributions, “as a pioneer in the development of in vitro biology and plant biotechnology, were of the highest scientific, professorial and humanitarian level.”

Keller received the award at the 2010 In Vitro Biology Meeting’s SIVB Business Meeting in St. Louis, Missouri. The other award winners were Donald E. Ingber, MD, PhD; and Peggy G. Lemaux, PhD.
